Transform a child's hospital experience

Child Life is not a billable medical service, but it adds an immeasurable benefit to lowering anxiety and improving healing.

It is purely patient and family-focused. An investment from LG Health and generous community support are essential to expand and sustain this service in perpetuity. The impact: A Child Life specialist has an average of 4,000 pediatric patient encounters each year.

- **LG Health:** will invest in two Child Life specialists to support children in the Center and Emergency Department.
- **Philanthropy:** will double the impact of Child Life by providing the funding for additional Child Life specialists and annual programming support to help meet the evolving medical needs of pediatric patients.
