

Child Life Program Donation Requirements

We thank you for your in-kind donation to the children and families at Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health! All donations are tax deductible and we ask that you kindly fill out our Gift-In-Kind form for our 501 3c status, and either email it back to us or deliver it with your donation.

Any donation made to the Pediatric Inpatient Center must be set up through the Child Life Program. Please contact Child Life by calling **717-544-8673**.

Due to HIPAA standards and Infection control regulations, donors are not permitted on the Pediatric Inpatient Center to hand deliver donated items. A Child Life Specialist is happy to meet with you to set up a donation drop off time.

Our typical slots are <u>Tuesdays and Thursdays</u> between the times of <u>8:30-9:30am or 3-5pm.</u> If you are unable to drop off your items during that time, we will provide you with additional instructions on how and where to drop off your items.

The Child Life Specialists will ensure your items are provided to the pediatric patients during the course of their hospitalization. These may include toys utilized to help distract patients from pain, to help with their overall coping or to celebrate a special event such as their birthday or holiday while in the hospital.

Out of concern for the hospitalized patients, items must be:

- Brand new
- From the store with tags attached
- Come from a smoke-free environment (ie home, car etc.)
